- * In 2008, Prism completed six energy studies and has an additional 30 studies currently at the application stage.
- * Prism has also been involved in our educational efforts: last year, the company assisted us in planning and facilitating the Energy Manager Training course for CIET (Canadian Institute for Energy Training)
- * Prism staff members, in collaboration with a Power Smart Program Manager, designed the Workplace Conservation Awareness initiative, which is now in its pilot stage. It's receiving a lot of positive feedback and, if successful, it could enable Power Smart to claim kWh savings from changes in people's behaviours.
- * We're all very excited about the work Prism is doing with BCIT to develop a one-year Energy Manager Certificate program.
